Next Gen Pedagogy

Our project-based curriculum goals are simple, we want to improve student engagement inside the classroom that will inspire students to a career pathway. We will succeed in this goal by having provided interactive learning material that will give students the opportunity to practice/apply what they learn from instruction in a real-world scenario. Materials provided by L2A will be hands-on projects that students solve in a creative and scientific process that concludes with open-ending interpretation. Studies indicate this is the best method at acquiring future interest in course material being presented. Unlike traditional instruction, completion of L2A project will integrate performance assessment ensuring standards completions while maintaining students interest.

Tried and Tested

Learn to Achieve has partnered with state sponsored programs, such as HSU's Talent Search and GEAR UP, to provide the STEAM curriculum that improves student's preparedness for the demands of today's careers while also encouraging parent engagement.
